



## Enchanted Boa

Jiboinha encantada

Enchanted Boa is a musical collaboration between Rua Inu Keã Huni Kuĩ and Txana Siriani.

Rooted in the ancestral traditions of the Huni Kuĩ people of the Amazon, their songs are received prayers – carried by voice, melody and rhythm, and guided by the spirits of Nature and the forest. In this work, song is not performance, but relationship: a living dialogue between human beings, ancestral lineages, and the unseen worlds.

The guiding spirit of this collaboration is Siriani, the enchanted boa – a guardian of remembrance, connection, and the safeguarding of living prayers.

### Xinã Kaĩma

Xinã Kaĩma is the debut album of Enchanted Boa.

The title comes from Hãtxa Kuĩ, the language of the Huni Kuĩ people of Brazil and Peru. Xinã Kaĩma refers to the purification of thoughts – the clearing of harmful energies and the welcoming of good, clear, and life-supporting thoughts.

The album is a compilation of 12 ceremonial healing songs: six led by Rua Inu Keã Huni Kuĩ, and six led by Txana Siriani. Together, the songs guide the listener through a ritual journey of healing, carried by the medicines and spirits of the enchanted forest, and accompanied by ancestral beings who join the prayers.

These songs are not composed in the conventional sense. They are received. The spirits sing through us. If you listen carefully, with presence, you may hear what they have to say.

## Who Is Singing

Rua Inu Keã Huni Kuĩ is a Huni Kuĩ man from the village of Boa Vista in the Kaxinawá Indigenous Territory of the Upper Jordão River, in the Brazilian Amazon. From early childhood, he has studied the ancestral traditions of his people – their spirituality, songs, healing sciences, and relationship with the forest – guided by his family and elders. Rua Inu is a Txana, a singer of sacred prayers, and a community leader devoted to preserving ancestral wisdom while building bridges with the wider world.

Txana Siriani (Minna Pyhälä) is a Finnish-born artist, storyteller, and cultural bridge between worlds. Raised across multiple cultures, her life has been shaped by a deep curiosity about existence and a devotion to living in harmony with Nature and Spirit. Her journey with the Huni Kuĩ people began in 2017. Through song, story, and prayer, she serves the remembering of living traditions with humility, care, and respect.

Rua Inu and Txana Siriani met in Boa Vista in 2022 and were married the following year, committing to walk and work together in service of Spirit, the sacred medicines, and their families and communities.
